STARS Registration and Updated Information is Important!

With the coming of the snow and cold that add to the beauty of Ohio's winters comes the almost certainty of snow and cold days in Ohio's schools. As a State Support Team that provides professional development across many districts and LEAs, our main method of communication with districts and LEAs is via the STARS portal.

On occasion, it becomes necessary to cancel a professional development opportunity due to severe wintry conditions and our most efficient way of contacting registered participants is through the STARS system. Relying on this system is contingent on two variables. First, participants must register for the professional development through STARS. If participants plan to simply attend the training without registering, we have no means of knowing that and no method of contacting them if the training is cancelled. Second, participants must keep their email addresses and other contact information up-to-date so that, when we email participants, they receive it at their current email address.

Registering for a SAFE account for STARS is a relatively painless process:

- 1. Go to http://webapp2.ode.state.oh.us/portal/
- 2. Select the "SAFE Sign Up" button at the left of the page
- 3. Read the agreement and click on "I Agree" at the bottom
- 4. Continue to follow the prompts on the screen

Be sure to write down your login information for future use. Finally, make sure to access this account and keep information up-to-date as you change phone numbers and emails addresses.

 - A. The impact the nominee(s) have had on the quality of life and learning for children with disabilities.
 - B. How the nominee(s) is/are an exceptional candidate(s) for this award.
