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## **2014 Kathe Shelby Leadership Award Recipient: Shawna Benson**

State Support Team Region 2 would like to congratulate Shawna Benson, Ohio Center for Autism and Low Incidence, for being awarded the 2014 Kathe Shelby Leadership Award. This award was presented by Sue Zake, Director of the Office for Exceptional Children of the Ohio Department of Education, during a special ceremony at the 2014 Special Education Leadership Conference in Columbus, OH. Shawna currently serves as the Program Director Center for Teaching Diverse Learners at OCALI.

Shawna was chosen for this award based upon her work across the state involving effective programming for diverse learners. She has developed a system for teachers of students with low incidence disabilities to approach the Common Core and Ohio's new learning standards through high grade-level expectations and planning. She has provided trainings around the state in conjunction with regional staff and continues to support those regional staff and teacher teams as they grow in their abilities to plan and instruct students at their grade and ability levels.

Shawna recognizes that many teachers of students with diverse learning needs work in isolation without the support of their peers. She also realizes that by working together teachers can accomplish more than by working alone, so she is leading a project that connects Ohio teachers by allowing them to share unit plans based on learning standards and her planning guides on the OCALI website.

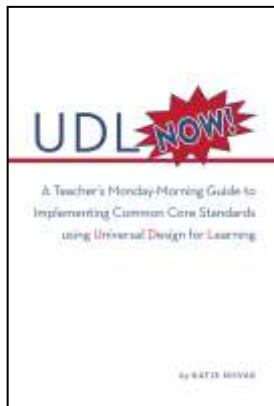

Not only has Shawna been supporting teachers within the County Board of DD settings as well as the public school settings, but has also supported those who are training to be teachers by developing and teaching courses at the university level. Shawna also co-developed the Ohio Academic Content Standards Extended (OACS-E) modules including: What Are Extended Academic Content Standards?; General Curriculum for Students with Significant Cognitive Disabilities; Planning for Instruction and Assessment for Students with Significant Cognitive Disabilities; Aligning Instruction with the Ohio ELA Content Standards – Extended; Aligning Instruction with the Ohio Mathematics Content Standards – Extended; Aligning Instruction with the Ohio Science Standards – Extended; and Aligning Instruction with the Ohio Social Studies Standards – Extended. On a national level, Shawna also collaborated with the National Consortium on Deaf-Blindness to develop modules on planning and balanced literacy instruction including: Strategies for Planning; Unit Planning; Tiered Planning; Daily Planning; and Collaborative Planning. These are free resources available to Ohio educators as well as educators across the country.

Shawna's skills and knowledge have touched educators of students with low incidence disabilities in the State Support Team Region 2 as well as across the state and nation. Please join us in congratulating Shawna on this high achievement!

with Dr. Maria Sargent

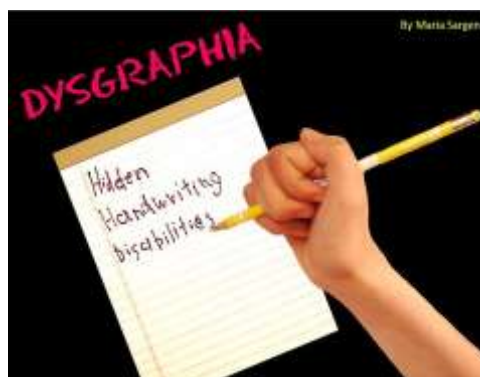

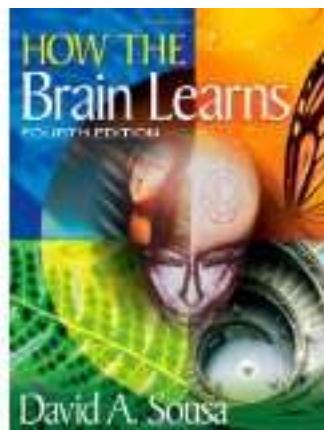
